

Adoption project successfully completed

In mid-February 2020, the Foundation Adoption Graves Nederweert War Cemetery took off. With the permission of the British Commonwealth War Graves Commission, the aim was to provide all graves with an adopter in the future. The old adoption register was slowly but surely replaced by a digital register.

All 363 graves adopted

A year later we can now proudly announce that all 363 graves have been adopted. The last available graves are reserved for primary schools in Nederweert. In the course of the year we will pay further attention to communicate with the schools. This had to be postponed due to the Covid-19 troubles.

In addition to many registrations from the municipality of Nederweert, there were also many registrations both nationally and internationally. We can now report that we have adopters in Canada, the United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand, Belgium and Brazil.

Despite the fact that all graves have now been adopted, interested parties can still register. Our foundation draws up a waiting list. Should an adopter give up his or her grave in the future, for whatever reason, this can be taken over.
