Private memorial service due to Covid-19

On 1 October last, a delegation from our foundation met with the 'Bond van Wapenbroeders chapter Ospel', the head of cabinet of the municipality of Nederweert under the guidance of mayor Birgit op de Laak. On the agenda was the November commemoration at the British war cemetery and the influence of Covid-19. The ceremony Lights on War Graves, which has been taking place for several years on Christmas Eve 24 December, was also discussed.

On Saturday, November 14, a small private memorial service will take place at the British war cemetery because of Covid-19 restrictions. On behalf of all adopters, only two adopters are allowed to be present and lay flowers at their graves.

All adopters are of course welcome to come and lay flowers. This is allowed on november the 11th , Remembrance Day (Poppy Day) itself or on saturday afternoon, november the 14th from 1 p.m. until sunset. And on sunday, november the 15th from sunrise to sunset. A small commemoration will take place on Christmas Eve the 24th of december, depending on the Covid-19 restrictions of that time.
